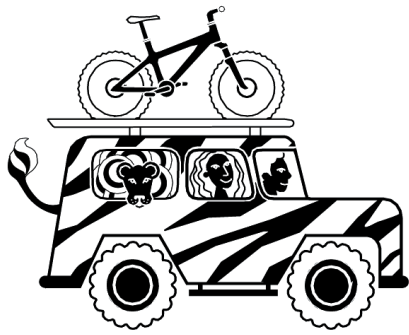

Racers from any town or state may enter. Riders must currently be enrolled in grades 6-12 and must be aged 18 or younger. School ID's may be checked. Mountain bikes in good working order are required. **Helmets are MANDATORY.** **Parents or guardians must be present** and sign a release form before any student may compete.

Prices and Prizes: \$15 entry fee for all classes. Medals and swag for all top finishers! Trophies for Series Champions!

Classifications:**

Men's B - Novice mountain biker with little or no racing experience.
Men's A - Experienced mountain biker with lots of riding or racing experience.
Women's Open - Novice and experienced bikers alike.

Middle school racers laps will be approximately 1.5 miles long, and high racers laps will be approximately 2 miles long. Trails will consist of flowing single track through the woods as well as a tour of some old Jungle Habitat attractions!

Middle School Men's B/Middle School Open Women - 9:00 a.m. Race length - 25 minutes.
Middle School Men's A - 9:30 a.m. Race length - 30 minutes.
High School Men's B and High School Open Women - 10:15 a.m. Race length - 35 minutes.
High School Men's A - 11:00 a.m. Race length - 45 minutes.
